From the Desk of Fr. David *Desde el Escritorio del Padre David*

MARY STAR OF THE SEA

This weekend, it is combined liturgy and popular devotion to Mary under the title Star of the Sea.

Scripture readings this Sunday speak of the importance of God's Word; a Word that is true and fulfills what it says. This is what the prophet Isaiah means when he says, "Just as from the heavens the rain and snow come down and do not return there till they have watered the earth, making it fertile and fruitful...so shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; my word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it". God does what he says. God has sown His Word in the world through Jesus and that Word will bear fruit if it "falls on the good ground," that is, if we are able to receive it in our hearts and put it into practice in our lives.



Today we celebrate the feast of the Virgin of Carmen. In 1251, the Virgin Mary, surrounded by a crowd of angels, appeared to St. Simon Stock with a scapular in his hand and promised that anyone who dies with the scapular will not suffer the eternal fire, that is, he will be saved.

The scapular is a piece of cloth that bears the image of the Virgin and signifies the love and maternal protection of Mary; That we belong to the Virgin, and the gentle yoke of Christ. Whoever wears the scapular must strive to always keep in mind our Lady and imitate her virtues. The scapular can be replaced by a medal bearing in one side the image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and on the other side an image of the Blessed Mother under any title. The scapular is a cord that is worn to the neck with two small pieces of brown cloth, one on the chest and the other on the back. It is worn under clothing and along with the rosary and the Miraculous Medal is one of the most important sacramental in the Catholic Church.

May God grant us the grace to die wearing the scapular of the Blessed Virgin Mary and thus enjoy God's presence quickly.

MARIA ESTRELLA DEL MAR

Este domingo se combinan la liturgia y la devoción popular que no dejará pasar la oportunidad de celebrar a la Estrella del Mar.

Las lecturas de este domingo hablan de la importancia de la Palabra de Dios, una Palabra que es verdadera y que cumple lo que dice.

Así lo manifiesta el profeta Isaías cuando dice que "como bajan la lluvia y la nieve desde el cielo, y no vuelven allá, sino después de empapar la tierra, de fecundarla y hacerla germinar... así será mi palabra, que sale de mi boca: no volverá a mí vacía, sino que hará mi voluntad y cumplirá mi encargo". Dios cumple lo que dice. Dios ha sembrado su Palabra en el mundo a través de Jesús y esa Palabra dará fruto si "cae en tierra buena", es decir, si somos capaces de acogerla en nuestro corazón y ponerla en práctica en nuestra vida.



Hoy celebramos la fiesta de la Virgen del Carmen. En 1251, la Virgen María, rodeada de una muchedumbre de ángeles, se apareció a San Simón Stock con un escapulario en la mano y prometió que quien muera con el escapulario puesto no padecerá el fuego eterno, es decir, se salvará.

El escapulario es un pedazo de tela que lleva la imagen de la Virgen y significa el amor y la protección maternal de María, que le pertenecemos a la Virgen y el suave yugo de Cristo.. Quien usa el escapulario debe procurar tener siempre a la Virgen Santísima e imitar sus virtudes. El escapulario de tela puede sustituirse por una medalla que lleve la imagen del Corazón de Jesús y por la otra una imagen de la Virgen bajo cualquier advocación.

El escapulario es un cordón que se lleva al cuello con dos piezas pequeñas de tela color café, una sobre el pecho y la otra sobre la espalda. Se usa bajo la ropa y junto con el rosario y la Medalla Milagrosa es uno de los sacramentales más importantes.

Dios quiera concedernos la gracia de morir vistiendo el escapulario de la Virgen y así gozar de la presencia de Dios rápidamente.




