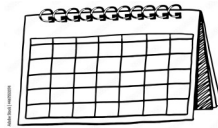

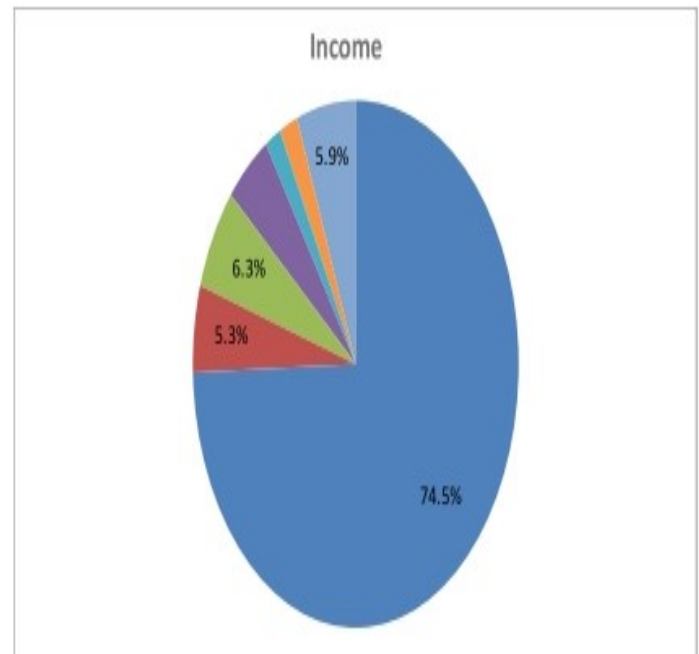

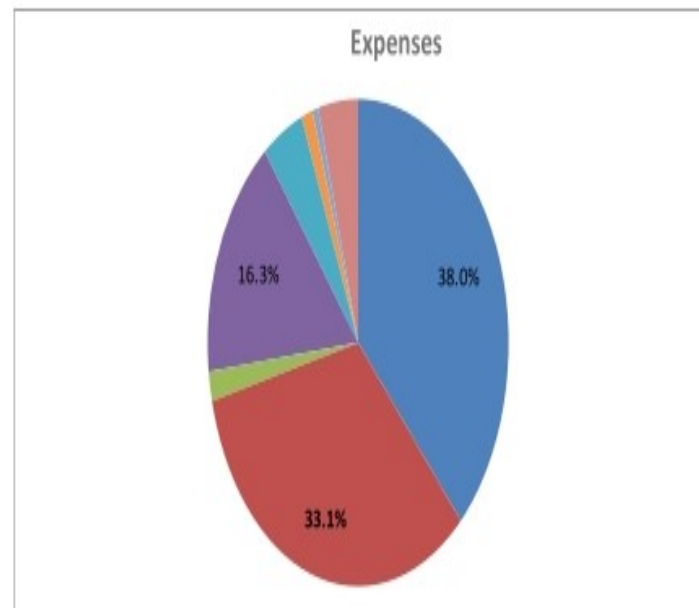


Obligations owed to the Oakland Diocese (2010 to 2016):

We paid \$42,246 towards 2016 & 2015 past debt to the Diocese, bringing down our debt to the to \$231,173 while not accruing additional debt.

Completed Facilities Projects in 2023:

1. Repair of the church, from the 100 square foot of fallen ceiling acoustical tile.
2. Repair of the Rectory, from the rusted gas pipe caused, fire in the crawlspace.
3. Repair and resurfacing of the church hall roof, both upper and lower.
4. The repair of the west outside door, on the lower floor of the Church Hall.
5. Replacement of a corroded and leaking water pipe in the rectory crawl space.
6. Replacement of the furnace in the church (flower room).
7. Addition of electrical outlet in the sacristy & Church front patio.
9. Replacement of broken breaker, in the main electrical panel of the Church Hall furnace room.
10. Addition of an additional camera in the Church Hall, lower floor.
11. Addition of multiple microphones to the church audio system.
